# Types of Booth Builds:

- 1. Exhibitor Appointed Contractor (EAC): You will appoint an external contractor to build your exhibit.
- 2. Freeman Build: Freeman will handle the construction of your booth.
- **3. Portable Booth (Pop-up):** You will manage the setup and dismantling of your booth without external (vendor) assistance.

## Sample Documents:

• COI – <u>insurance requirements</u>

**Technical drawings** must include all dimensions of your booth construction, a description of your flooring materials (including the height of raised platform floors), and a description of your boundary walling construction materials. If you are planning to have a rigged banner over your stand space, you must include on your drawing the dimensions, weight, and construction materials of your rigged banner.
